AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING AN AMENDMENT OF THE FY10 SEWER FUND BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the FY10 Sewer Fund budget was created with certain estimates for environmental legal services, and;

WHEREAS, as the year has progressed it has been determined that those estimates will not be sufficient to cover all of the costs of the City's environmental attorneys, Aqualaw LLC, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to update the budget to reflect new estimates;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the City's Fiscal Year 2010 Sewer Fund budget be and is hereby amended as follows:

- 1) Increase the current surplus account for the Sewer Fund by \$430,000 \$350,000
- 2) Increase the Sewer Fund expenses by \$430,000 \$350,000


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.

Subject: Budget Amendment for Sewer Fund FY10 Budget

Attached is the Ordinance for a budget amendment for the FY10 Sewer Fund budget. The Waste Water Treatment Plant Upgrade has required the legal services of Aqualaw PLC to help in the resolution of the construction issues. The invoices for these services are averaging about \$26,775 per month and have depleted the FY10 "Other Attorney" account. A Transfer of Funds to cover the July, August, September invoices took funds from the WWTP Equipment account in the amount of \$70,000. These funds will need to be replaced for operation of the Waste Water Treatment Plant during the last half of the Fiscal Year.

Current Avg. \$27,000 per month x 9 mo. = 243,000Owed back to WWTP $\pm 70,000$ Total Before Litigation 313,000

Estimated Additional \$13,000 per mo. X 9mo. = \$117,000 Total Amount Needed \$430,000

With the announcement of the lawsuit filed against a City contractor, we anticipate greater monthly invoices from Aqualaw PLC over the remainder of FY10.
