

ORDINANCE NO. 2176

AN ORDINANCE of the City Council of the City of Salisbury to establish a fee schedule to register a foreclosed residential property.

WHEREAS, Chapter 15.21 requires that within 5 (five) days after the person authorized to make sale of a residential property has filed an order to docket or complaint to foreclose a mortgage or deed of trust on residential property located within the City of Salisbury; and

WHEREAS, Section 15.21.040 establishes that a fee shall be imposed for registration of a foreclosed residential property.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the City Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland, in regular session, that the fee schedule shall be as follows:


\$25.00 per foreclosed property registration.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, that the Ordinance will take effect upon final passage.


