

AS AMENDED ON FEBRUARY 13, 2012
ORDINANCE NO. 2190

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING A BUDGET ADMENDMENT OF THE FY12 GENERAL FUND TO APPROPRIATE THE FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT INSURANCE TRUST (LGIT) FOR DAMAGE INCURED BY A LIGHTNING STRIKE TO THE POLICE RADIO TOWER ON MARINE ROAD.

WHEREAS, the police radio tower was seriously damaged by a lightning strike that occurred on August 2, 2011; and,

WHEREAS, the insurance claim paid by the Local Government Insurance Trust amounted to \$21,033.59, which was deposited into the City of Salisbury's General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has insufficient funds in the building maintenance account, 21021-534301 to pay the vender, Teltronic Inc. for this unbudgeted emergency repair work to the tower site for the same amount of \$21,033.59.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, that the City's Fiscal Year 2012 General Fund Budget be amended as follows:

- 1) Increase ~~Current Surplus Insurance Proceeds~~ (01000 469810 456935) by \$21,033.59
- 2) Increase the Police Department budget by \$21,033.59

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.



On August 2, 2011, the police radio tower located on Marine Road was severely damaged by a lighting strike. The Teltronic Company was contacted and immediately responded to make the emergency repairs which totaled \$21,033.59. An insurance claim was submitted and payment of this claim was placed in the City's General Fund account.

The Salisbury Police Department is requesting a budget amendment to appropriate these funds and pay the vendor, Teltronic Inc.
