## AS AMENDED ON FEBRUARY 13, 2012 ORDINANCE NO. 2190 3 4 5 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING A BUDGET 6 ADMENDMENT OF THE FY12 GENERAL FUND TO APPROPRIATE THE FUNDS 7 RECEIVED FROM THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT INSURANCE TRUST (LGIT) FOR 8 DAMAGE INCURED BY A LIGHTNING STRIKE TO THE POLICE RADIO TOWER ON 9 MARINE ROAD. 10 11 WHEREAS, the police radio tower was seriously damaged by a lightning strike that 12 occurred on August 2, 2011; and, 13 14 WHEREAS, the insurance claim paid by the Local Government Insurance Trust 15 amounted to \$21,033.59, which was deposited into the City of Salisbury's General Fund; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the Police Department has insufficient funds in the building maintenance 18 account, 21021-534301 to pay the vender, Teltronic Inc. for this unbudgeted emergency repair 19 work to the tower site for the same amount of \$21,033.59. 20 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY 22 OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, that the City's Fiscal Year 2012 General Fund Budget be 23 amended as follows: 24 25 1) Increase Current Surplus Insurance Proceeds (01000 469810 456935) by \$21,033.59 26 2) Increase the Police Department budget by \$21,033.59 27 28 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the 29 date of its final passage. -30 THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a meeting of the Council of the City of 31 Salisbury held on this 13<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2012, and thereafter, a statement of the substance of 32 33 the Ordinance having been published as required by law, was finally passed by the Council on 34 day of Jebruary, 2012. 35 36 ATTEST: Terry E.
