

ORDINANCE NO. 2199

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING AN AMENDMENT OF THE FY 12 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR GASOLINE AND DIESEL FUEL FOR THE SANITATION COLLECTION/DISPOSAL DIVISION.

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury Department of Public Works Sanitation Collection/Disposal Division provides residential trash service; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitation Collection/Disposal Division depends upon gasoline and diesel fuel to provide the trash collection service; and

WHEREAS, the price of gasoline and diesel fuel has increased and has placed additional pressure on this account; and

WHEREAS, due to a projection error for the FY12 budget, there were insufficient funds provided in the FY12 budget in the Sanitation Collection/Disposal Division's gasoline account; and

WHEREAS, the combination of the error in projection and the rise in gasoline and diesel fuel prices has caused a projected shortfall in the gasoline account in this Division of \$20,000.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the City's Fiscal Year 2012 General Fund budget be and are hereby, amended as follows:

- 1) Increase the General Fund Revenue Current Surplus Available Account (01000-469810) by \$20,000
- 2) Increase Sanitation Budget by \$20,000


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.
