

AS AMENDED ON 4-23-12
ORDINANCE NO. 2200

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE FY12 GENERAL FUND AND SEWER FUND BUDGETS TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS TO COVER LEGAL EXPENSES.

WHEREAS, the FY12 General Fund and Sewer Fund budgets were created with certain estimates for legal services; and

WHEREAS, as the year has progressed it has been determined that those estimates will not be sufficient to cover all of the costs of the City's Attorney in the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, as the year has progressed it has been determined that those estimates will not be sufficient to cover all of the costs of the City's Wastewater Treatment Plant litigation attorneys, Goldberg, Besche & Banks, P.C., the former City Attorney, expert testimony and other litigation expenses; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to have sufficient funds appropriated to meet its expected legal obligations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the City's Fiscal Year 2012 General Fund budget be and is hereby amended as follows:

- 1) Increase the Current Surplus account for the General Fund (01000-469810) by \$70,000 ~~\$30,000~~ \$100,000
- 2) Increase the General Fund City Attorney expenses by \$70,000 ~~\$30,000~~ \$100,000

AND, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED THAT THE City's Fiscal Year 2012 Sewer Fund budget be and is hereby amended as follows:

- 1) Increase the Current Surplus Account in the Sewer Fund (60100-469810) by \$565,000
- 2) Increase the Sewer Fund expenses by \$565,000

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on the 9th day of April, 2012, and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, was finally passed by the Council on the 23rd day of April, 2012.
