ORDINANCE No. 2204

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING A BUDGET AMENDMENT OF THE FY12 GENERAL FUND TO APPROPRIATE THE ADDITIONAL FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE MARYLAND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (MEMA) FOR EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CONDUCTED IN PREPARATION AND DURING HURRICANE IRENE IN AUGUST 2011.

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury conducted emergency operations to protect the citizens during Hurricane Irene; and

WHEREAS, several City departments participated in the emergency operations and expended funds from their budgets; and

WHEREAS, MEMA approved reimbursement of a percentage of the expenses; and

WHEREAS, additional reimbursement funds have been promised from MEMA in the amount of \$4,497.86; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, that the City's Fiscal year 2012 General Fund Budget be amended as follows:


- 1) Increase General Fund Revenue – miscellaneous account (01000-46911) by \$4,497.86
- 2) Increase Fire Department budget by \$4,497.86

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.


