

AS AMENDED ON JULY 9, 2012

ORDINANCE NO. 2207

AN ORDINANCE of the City of Salisbury, Maryland changing Bateman Street from two-way to one-way westbound between South Division Street and Wayne Street (eastern leg); prohibiting left-hand turns by vehicles from South Division Street onto Bateman Street; erecting a traffic signal and pedestrian indications indicators at the intersection of Onley Road and South Division Street; establishing a bicycle lane on Bateman Street; and ~~striping~~ establishing pedestrian crosswalks at the Onley Road ~~intersection with~~ and South Division Street intersection.

WHEREAS, South Division Street near the intersections with Bateman Street and Onley Road have safety and operational issues; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury desires to signalize the intersection of South Division Street and Onley Road to improve the safety and operation of the intersection; and

WHEREAS, in order to signalize the intersection of South Division Street and Onley Road, Bateman Street vehicular traffic must become one-way westbound between South Division Street and Wayne Street (eastern leg).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that Bateman Street be made one-way westbound between South Division Street and Wayne Street (eastern leg); ~~prohibit~~ that left-hand turns by vehicles from South Division Street onto Bateman Street be prohibited; ~~erect~~ a that traffic and pedestrian signals and ~~pedestrian indications~~ be erected at the intersection of Onley Road and South Division Street; ~~establish~~ that a bicycle lane be established on Bateman Street; and ~~stripe~~ that pedestrian crosswalks be established at the intersection of Onley Road ~~Intersection with~~ and South Division Street.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, that the Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage.

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland held on the 2nd day of July, 2012 and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, in the meantime, was finally passed by the Council on the 9th day of July, 2012.
