**ORDINANCE NO. 2210**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING A BUDGET AMENDMENT OF THE FY2013 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE RENEGOTIATION OF THE CITY'S CABLE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the City's Cable Franchise Agreement with Comcast expires in January 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council believe it is in the City's best interest to engage the services of a consultant to assist with the renegotiation of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, in FY2012 the City of Salisbury solicited bids for the renegotiation of the City's Cable Franchise Agreement, assess community needs, provide a technical evaluation, assess past performance and franchise compliance review, perform a franchise audit, and draft the renewal agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury is requesting to award the bid to CBG Communications, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the FY13 Budget to appropriate funds for this purpose; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the City's Fiscal Year 2013 Budget be and is hereby, amended as follows:


- 1) Increase Current Surplus Available by \$70,000.00. (01000-469810)
- 2) Increase the Mayor's Office Budget by \$70,000.00

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.


THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a meeting of the City Council held on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2012, and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, was finally passed by the Council on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of July, 2012.
