

**AS AMENDED ON JULY 9, 2012 and JULY 23, 2012**

**ORDINANCE NO. 2212**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND  
TO AMEND THE FISCAL YEAR 2013 BUDGET TO PROVIDE FUNDS  
FOR THE CONTINUED ACQUISITION OF COMCATE LICENSING.

WHEREAS, the Comcate database was initially acquired through the Safe Streets Grant  
in 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Neighborhood Services and Code Compliance (NSCC)  
was informed of the loss ~~for~~ of that funding through the upcoming round of Safe  
Streets Grant funding; and

WHEREAS, NSCC informed the administration during the FY 13 budget preparations of  
the potential loss of funding; and

WHEREAS, the Comcate database has become our primary code enforcement tool; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate the funding to continue our relationship with  
Comcate; and


NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury,  
Maryland that the City's Fiscal Year 2013 General Fund budget be amended as  
follows:


- 1) Increase the General Fund Current Surplus Available account (01000-469810)  
by \$6,800.00
- 2) Increase Neighborhood Services and Code Compliance budget by \$6,800.00

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, that the Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage.


