**ORDINANCE NO. 2222**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING AN AMENDMENT OF THE FY 13 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO COVER WARRANT SERVICE COSTS INVOICED THE POLICE DEPARTMENT CONSULTING COSTS FOR WARRANT SERVICE BY THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE INCURRED IN FY 12

WHEREAS, in FY 2012 the City of Salisbury Police Department ~~incurred consulting costs with the~~ was invoiced by the Maryland State Police for warrant services costs; and

WHEREAS; the City's FY 2012 budget contained an appropriation to cover this contract; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department's purchase requisition for this expense was not processed at FY 2012 year end; and

WHEREAS, the City's FY 2013 budget does not contain an appropriation to cover this expense; and


WHEREAS, this expense is an obligation that the City must pay.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the City's Fiscal Year 2013 General Fund Budget be and hereby is amended as follows:

- 1) Increase General Fund Current Surplus Available account (01000-469810) by \$16,421; and
- 2) Increase the Police Department budget by \$16,421.


