

AS AMENDED ON FEBRUARY 25, 2013 and March 11, 2013
ORDINANCE No. 2234

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING A BUDGET ADMENDMENT OF THE FY13 GENERAL FUND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE SPEED CAMERA PROGRAM FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A FENCE AT THE CITY'S POLICE RANGE.

WHEREAS, the property owned by the City of Salisbury and utilized by the Police Department for firearms training and qualifications currently has unrestricted access; and

WHEREAS, any unauthorized person(s) can be on the property during live weapons firing with the potential for injury, creating serious liability issues; and

WHEREAS, the construction of this fence and posting of the property will restrict unauthorized persons from gaining access, thereby protecting the public from injury and the City from lawsuits; and

WHEREAS, this fencing will also define the boundaries of the City's property and protect the buildings and equipment from theft or damage; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has insufficient funds in the Buildings & Maintenance Account, 21021-534301 to pay the ~~vender~~ vendor, Anderson Fence Company, Inc., in the amount of \$32,480.00.

WHEREAS, there are Speed Camera funds in excess of \$32,480 collected in FY12 which have not been appropriated and remain available for appropriation for the purpose of public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, THAT THE City's Fiscal Year 2013 General Fund Budget be amended as follows:

- 1) Increase Current Year Surplus (01000-469810) by \$32,480.00
- 2) Increase the Police Department budget by \$32,480.00

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on this 25th day of February, 2013, and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, was finally passed by the Council on the 11th day of March, 2013.


SUBJECT: Ordinance – Requesting Speed Camera Funds for Fencing the City Police Range

The Salisbury Police Department respectfully requests a transfer in the amount of \$32,480.00 to the Police Services-Building & Maintenance account by increasing funds to be used from surplus. This transfer is for the purchase and installation of 2,754 feet of linear fencing for the Salisbury Police Department's Firing Range.

Due to the mandated weapons qualifications and firearms training which takes place regularly on this property, there is a real liability issue if unauthorized persons are on the property during any training period. Additionally, this action will define the boundaries of the City's property and safeguard the property and buildings by deterring foot traffic on or through the property.

The Salisbury Police Department is requesting a budget amendment to appropriate these funds and make payment to the Anderson Fence Company, Inc. the approved vendor.
