## AS AMENDED ON APRIL 8, 2013 ORDINANCE No. 2242

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY SETTING UPDATED FALSE ALARM FEES.

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury has a false alarm ordinance and desires to update the fees associated with false alarm responses by the Salisbury Police Department and the Salisbury Fire Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, that **Title 8 Health and Safety Section 8.04.050A** of the City Code is amended to add the following fee schedule to the end of Section 8.04.050A:

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage and that any fees incurred on or after since March 4, 2013, shall be reduced to the same level set by this Ordinance.
