ORDINANCE NO. 2247

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING A BUDGET AMENDMENT OF THE FY13 GENERAL FUND TO APPROPRIATE THE FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE MARYLAND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (MEMA) FOR EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CONDUCTED IN PREPARATION AND DURING HURRICANE SANDY IN OCTOBER 2012.

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury conducted emergency operations to protect the citizens during Hurricane Sandy; and

WHEREAS, several City departments participated in the emergency operations and expended funds from their budgets; and

WHEREAS, MEMA approved reimbursement of seventy-five percent of the expenses; and

WHEREAS, reimbursement funds have been received from MEMA in the amount of \$100,509.57; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, that the City's Fiscal year 2013 General Fund and Water and Sewer Budgets be amended as follows:

1a) Increase General Fund Revenue – miscellaneous account (01000-46911) by \$82,557.28

1b) Increase the following expenditure categories:

i. Increase the Police Department budget by \$16,222.09

ii. Increase Public Works Department budgets as follows:

1. Increase the Recreation and Culture budget by \$1,937.63

2. Increase the Sanitation budget by \$22,235.33

3. Increase the Resource Mgmt/Engineering \$33,057.94

iii. Increase Fire Department budget by \$9,091.35

2a) Increase Water & Sewer Revenue – miscellaneous account (60100-456911) by \$17,952.29

2b) Increase the following expenditure categories:

i. Increase the Water & Sewer budget by \$4,364.36


ii. Increase the Water Treatment budget by \$4,300.44


iii. Increase the Waste Water Treatment budget by \$9,287.49

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.


