

AS AMENDED ON JUNE 3, 2013  
ORDINANCE No. 2254

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING A BUDGET AMENDMENT OF THE FY2013 GENERAL FUND, WATER AND SEWER FUND, AND PARKING FUND BUDGETS TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR TRANSFERS TO THE HEALTH CARE RESERVE FUND.

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury has a Health Care Reserve Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury is a member of the Wicomico County Public Entities Consortium ("WCPE") which requires that it maintain Reserve funds to pay for health care settlements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury General Fund, Water and Sewer fund, Parking Authority, collectively will transfer during FY 2013 \$487,000 to the Health Care Reserve Fund in order to build the reserves in the Health Care Reserve Fund.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, THAT THE City's Fiscal Year 2013 Budget be amended as follows:

1. In the General Fund, increase by \$386,000 the amount budgeted for 'Transfer to – Health Care Reserve Fund' by increasing the Current Year Surplus.
2. In the Water and Sewer fund, increase by \$87,096 the amount budgeted for the "Transfer to – Health Care Reserve Fund" by increasing the Current Year Surplus.
3. In the Parking fund, increase by \$13,494 the amount budgeted for the "Transfer to – Health Care Reserve Fund" by increasing the Current Year Surplus.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June, 2013, and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, was finally passed by the Council on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2013.
