ORDINANCE No. 2283

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY AMENDING THE FY14 GENERAL FUND TO APPROPRIATE \$10,000 FOR A CONTRIBUTION TO SUPPORT THE 2014 RED, WHITE AND BOOM FIREWORKS DISPLAY

WHEREAS, a committee of citizens has organized to stage a fireworks display to celebrate our Nation's Independence Day this year; and

WHEREAS, a number of businesses, institutions and individuals are supporting this event through both cash and in-kind contributions; and

WHEREAS, it is important that the City join with the other supporters in the community and express their appreciation for the efforts of these citizens to stage this celebration; and

WHEREAS, it was determined during first reading on March 24, 2014, that the appropriate course of action is to direct \$9,000.00 (nine thousand dollars) to the Red, White and Boom for the 2014 celebration and that \$1,000.00 (one thousand dollars) be advanced to the endowment fund.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, THAT THE City's Fiscal Year 2014 General Fund Budget be and is hereby amended as follows:

- 1) Increase General Fund Revenue-Current Surplus Available - \$10,000 (01000-469810)
- 2) Increase General Fund-Mayor's Office/Community Promotions - \$10,000


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on this 24th day of March, 2014, and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, was finally passed by the Council on the 14th day of April, 2014.
