A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2019 ACCEPTING A DONATION OF A SURPLUS SERVER FROM THE WICOMICO COUNTY IT DEPARTMENT FOR USE AS THE CITY OF SALISBURY'S NEW WEB SERVER.

WHEREAS, at its January 24, 2011 meeting the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2019 accepting a donation of a surplus server from the Wicomico County IT Department for use as the City of Salisbury's new web server; and


WHEREAS, subsequent to that meeting it was discovered that there was a misunderstanding and that the Wicomico County IT Department did not intend to actually give the server to the City; and


WHEREAS, the actual intent of the Wicomico County IT Department was to allow the City to use the server through the "Shared Resources Agreement" as the City's new web server.




