

RESOLUTION NO. 2023

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY ACCEPTING FEDERAL GRANT FUNDS AWARDED THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE'S BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM FOR THE PURCHASE OF PROTECTIVE VESTS FOR EACH POLICE OFFICER.

WHEREAS, federal grant funds have been awarded by the U.S. Department of Justice's Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program;

WHEREAS, these federal grant funds will provide for 50% in matching funds to the City of Salisbury, and over the course of the grant will assist with the purchase of 68 vests.

WHEREAS, these federal grant funds will allow the Salisbury Police Department to purchase replace protective vests for each police officer as such time as the officers current vest warranty expires, usually after five years service;


WHEREAS, these vests will provide added protection against serious injury.



This Award expires on August 31, 2012.




