

**RESOLUTION NO. 2056**

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY TO SEND A LETTER TO THE WICOMICO COUNTY FINANCE DEPARTMENT INDICATING THE CITY'S FY 2012 TAX RATE BY JUNE 10, 2011.

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury is in the process of finalizing its FY 2012 budget; and

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Finance Department does the annual billing of the City of Salisbury real property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Finance Department has requested the City's real property tax rate by June 10, 2011 for FY 2012; and

WHEREAS, the City has not yet adopted the FY 2012 budget, but the City Council has agreed to the tax rate; and

WHEREAS, the City Council requests that the administration send a letter to the Director of Finance for Wicomico County, signed by the Mayor, indicating our tax rate will remain the same as FY 2011, on or before June 10, 2011; and


WHEREAS, the City Council understands that the budget ordinance ultimately sets the tax rate and if the final ordinance has a different rate than stated in the letter, Wicomico County may charge additional costs to the City for its tax billing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland does hereby authorize the Mayor of the City of Salisbury to send a letter to the Wicomico County Finance Department on or before June 10, 2011 indicating the City of Salisbury tax rate will remain the same as FY 2011 for FY 2012.

THE ABOVE RESOLUTION was introduced and duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland held on May 23, 2011, and is to become effective immediately.


