

RESOLUTION NO. 2064

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY TO ADD TWO VEHICLES, A 2000 JAGUAR AND A 2006 CHRYSLER 300M, TO THE SALISBURY POLICE DEPARTMENT'S VEHICLE FLEET, THAT HAVE BEEN FORFEITED BY THE CIRCUIT COURT OF WICOMICO COUNTY TO BE UTILIZED BY OFFICERS OF THE SALISBURY POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, as the result of a criminal case adjudication by the Circuit Court of Wicomico County, two vehicles have been forfeited to the Salisbury Police Department; and

WHEREAS, if accepted, the first vehicle, a 2000 Jaguar, VIN#: SAJDA01D3YGL14004, valued at approximately \$5,000.00, has a \$500.00 title lien which would need to be satisfied by the City of Salisbury; and

WHEREAS, the second vehicle, a 2006 Chrysler 300M, VIN#: 2C3KA43R76H461096, is valued at \$10,000.00 and has a clear title; and


WHEREAS, the Salisbury Police Department has funds within the budget to satisfy the aforementioned lien; and


WHEREAS, these two vehicles will be incorporated into the Salisbury Police Department's vehicle fleet and as authorized by the Chief of Police, will be utilized by officers for various details, as a tool for the enhancement of public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, that these two forfeited vehicles, a 2000 Jaguar and a 2006 Chrysler 300M, with a combined value of \$15,000.00 be added to the Salisbury Police Department's fleet for the enhancement of public safety for the City of Salisbury.

THIS RESOLUTION was introduced and duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland held on June 13, 2011 and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.



SUBJECT: Resolution – Forfeited Vehicles

Attached is a Resolution requesting that the Council approve the addition of two forfeited vehicles to the Salisbury Police Department's vehicle fleet. These vehicles were forfeited by the Circuit Court of Wicomico County in the disposition of a criminal case.

One of the vehicles has a \$500 lien against the title, which would have to be satisfied and funds are available in the Salisbury Police Department's budget. The other vehicle has a clear title and their combined estimated value is \$15,000. These vehicles will be utilized for various operations and details by Police Department personnel.
