

RESOLUTION NO. 2100

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ACCEPTING A DONATION OF \$1,000.00 FROM THE WINTER WONDERLAND OF LIGHTS COMMITTEE FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT SERVING THE WINTER WONDERLAND EXHIBITS.

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury has partnered with the Winter Wonderland of Lights Committee in the annual display of holiday lights in City Park;

WHEREAS, electrical boxes and panels used in connection with this display were stripped of copper during an act of theft discovered on April 20, 2011;


WHEREAS, the Local Government Insurance Trust will reimburse the City for this loss totaling \$5,721.35 except for the \$1,000.00 deductible; and


WHEREAS, the Winter Wonderland of Lights Committee wishes to donate \$1,000.00 to assist with the cost of replacement of the equipment and cover the City's deductible;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, that the donation of \$1,000.00 from the Winter Wonderland of Lights Committee is accepted contingent upon the adoption of the budget amendment for the use of these funds.

THIS RESOLUTION was introduced and duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland held on September 12, 2011 and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.

Re: Replacement of Winter Wonderland of Lights electrical equipment

On April 20, 2011, the theft of copper from and damage to approximately 40 electric outlet boxes and 3 large electric panel boxes used in connection with the Winter Wonderland of Lights was discovered and reported to the police. On July 26, 2011, a claim for the loss was filed with the Local Government Insurance Trust (LGIT).

Based on a quote from United Electric Supply, the replacement of the equipment will cost approximately \$5,721.35. LGIT has agreed to pay for the replacement with the understanding that the City bears responsibility for the \$1,000.00 deductible. By accepting a donation of \$1,000.00 from the Winter Wonderland of Lights Committee for the deductible and a payment up to \$4,721.35 from LGIT, the equipment can be replaced.

Attached is a Resolution for accepting the donation from the Winter Wonderland of Lights Committee and an Ordinance for the budget amendment adding up to \$5,721.35 into the Public Works – Traffic Control account.
