A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ACCEPTING FUNDS IN COOPERATION WITH THE MARYLAND OFFICE OF HIGHWAY SAFETY TO PROVIDE OVERTIME REIMBURSEMENT TO POLICE OFFICERS PARTICIPATING IN TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DURING THE 2012 "BIKE WEEK" TO REDUCE THE OCCURRENCE OF UNSAFE AND UNLAWFUL ACTIONS OF DRIVERS WHO DEMONSTRATE A CONSCIOUS AND WILLFUL DISREGARD OF TRAFFIC SAFETY.


WHEREAS, this grant funding has been designated for proactive enforcement efforts; and


WHEREAS, the use of these overtime funds will allow for increased police presence during the 2012 "Bike Week" event.
