

RESOLUTION NO. 2110

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ACCEPTING FEDERAL FUNDS AWARDED BY THE U.S. JUSTICE DEPARTMENT THROUGH AN EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM FOR MAINTAINING AND UPGRADING THE TECHNOLOGY OF THE SALISBURY POLICE DEPARTMENT IN THE AREAS OF CREATING AN INTELLIGENCE ANALYSIS SYSTEM, PROGRAM TRAINING, AND COMPUTER TECHNOLOGY SUPPORT.

WHEREAS, this Justice Assistance Grant is awarded by the Federal Government to improve public safety by reducing crime; and

WHEREAS, these grant funds will be divided between the Salisbury Police Department and the Wicomico County Sheriff's Office as agreed to by an Interlocal Agreement; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be utilized to create an Intelligence Analysis System for the Salisbury Police Department; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be utilized for training new and current employees of the Salisbury Police Department and the Wicomico County State's Attorney's Office in reference to the new Analysis System as well as the current systems already being used; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be utilized to secure outside computer technology support when required.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that a grant from the U.S. Justice Department in the amount of \$68,807 be accepted and of those funds \$12,007 be forwarded to the Wicomico County Sheriff's Office in accordance with an Interlocal Agreement between the City and the County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City's share will be used for maintaining and upgrading the technology of the Salisbury Police Department.
