

RESOLUTION NO. 2152

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND TO DESIGNATE THE CITY OF SALISBURY AS A SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITY, PURSUANT TO THE ATTACHED SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITY AREA MAP {AND SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITY PLAN (THE "PLAN") AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN THE SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITY APPLICATION (THE "APPLICATION")}, FOR APPROVAL EITHER DIRECTLY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT (THE "DEPARTMENT") OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND OR THROUGH THE SMART GROWTH SUBCABINET OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland recognizes that there is a significant need for reinvestment and revitalization in the City of Salisbury; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland proposes to (1) designate the City of Salisbury Sustainable Community Area, as outlined on the attached map (the "Area"), as a Sustainable Community, and (2) to adopt the Plan, as further described in the Application, for the purposes of contributing to the reinvestment and revitalization in the Area; and

WHEREAS, the Area is located within a priority funding area under Section 5-7B-02 of the Smart Growth Act; and


WHEREAS, the applicable law and the Community Legacy Program regulations require a local government to submit an application to the Department in order to become a designated Sustainable Community, and to adopt a satisfactory Sustainable Community Plan in order to be eligible to receive financial assistance under the Community Legacy Program.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland hereby (1) endorses the designation of the Area as a Sustainable Community; and (2) adopts the Sustainable Community Plan described in the Application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the Mayor, the City Administrator, and the Director of Community Development of the City of Salisbury are hereby authorized to execute documents and take any action necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution; and


