

RESOLUTION NO. 2153

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ACCEPTING FUNDS FROM THE WICOMICO COUNTY NARCOTICS TASK FORCE TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT AND/OR FUND TRAINING FOR OFFICERS THEREBY ENHANCING LAW ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS TO PROVIDE A SAFER ENVIRONMENT FOR THE CITIZENS OF SALISBURY AND WICOMICO COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Narcotics Task Force has offered a \$5,000 grant to the Salisbury Police Department to fund the purchase of equipment; and


WHEREAS, these funds may also be used to cover the cost of training for Salisbury Police Officers; and




