A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY ACCEPTING TEN (10) WINCHESTER 1200 SHOTGUNS DONATED TO THE SALISBURY POLICE DEPARTMENT BY THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE THROUGH THE FEDERAL WEAPONS TRANSFER PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Federal Weapons Transfer Program endorses the donation of surplus weapons between law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland State Police has ten (10) fully operational Winchester 1200 shotguns which they will donate to the Salisbury Police Department; and


WHEREAS, the Salisbury Police Department has use for these weapons; and

WHEREAS, these weapons will be assigned only to officers specifically trained in their operation and for situations where other weapons are not practical.


