RESOLUTION NO. 2169

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM SALISBURY UNIVERSITY FOR STREETScape IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, Salisbury University is making funds available for additional sidewalk and street lighting improvements in association with the Onley/Bateman Safety Improvement Project: and,

WHEREAS, Salisbury University contributes these funds for the City of Salisbury to use for specific improvements: and,

WHEREAS, the intersection and street improvements include:

1. Constructing a "pork chop island" on Bateman Street at the intersection of South Division Street with curb and gutter as to only allow one-way traffic proceeding westbound on Bateman Street to Wayne Street; and,
2. Narrowing of the south side of Bateman Street (Wayne Street to South Division Street) to allow a 7' grass plot and an 8' sidewalk; and,
3. Install 14 decorative LED lights in this area for pedestrian safety; and,
4. Relocating a storm drain inlet at the new street width: and,


WHEREAS, the entire estimated cost for all improvements is approximately \$180,000.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland ~~to accept these that the City accept the~~ Salisbury University improvement funds of (\$180,000) for the ~~betterment of the City and its residents~~ improvements described herein,



Attached for Council consideration is a Resolution accepting a gift from Salisbury University (SU) to provide streetscape and safety improvements to the Bateman Street portion of the Onley/Bateman Safety Improvement Project. The funds will cover the following improvements:

1. Constructing a "pork chop island" on Bateman Street at the intersection of South Division Street with curb and gutter as to only allow one-way traffic proceeding westbound on Bateman Street to Wayne Street; and,
2. Narrowing of the south side of Bateman Street (Wayne Street to South Division Street) to allow a 7' grass plot and an 8' sidewalk; and,
3. Install 14 decorative LED lights in this area for pedestrian safety; and,
4. Relocating a storm drain inlet at the new street width.

The total engineer's estimate for these improvements is \$180,000. SU will be presenting a gift to the City in this amount. These improvements will greatly enhance the pedestrian safety improvements the City is constructing at the intersection of Onley Road and South Division Street. Public Works appreciates the partnership with SU and their dedication to improving the safety in this area and also their help in the beautification of the streets around their campus.
