





The City of Salisbury participates with the Board of Education of Wicomico County and Wicomico County on a GASB 45 Trust. The two other members also participate in a retirement trust. The Retirement Plan Investment Trustees consists of 3 community members, 2 Wicomico County Board of Education employee participants, 2 Wicomico County government employee participants and 1 County & 1 Board Finance or Human Resource representative. The GASB 45 trustees are the same as above, plus three trustees appointed by the Salisbury City Council. The terms are basically staggered within each group.

On March 8, 2011, Mr. Ramon (Ray) J. Matheu, one of the community members, was reappointed to the board as a community member and has since resigned. As such, Mr. Brad Bellaccico has been nominated by the board of trustees to fill the opening on the board. We are requesting that the City Council consider and approve Mr. Bellaccico to complete the term ending February 2014.
