of service to homeless residents of the City of Salisbury, Wicomico County; and


WHEREAS, a supplemental grant in the amount of \$27,000.00 was awarded to  
the City of Salisbury for the following program;



and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Mayor James Ireton, Jr. is authorized and

On behalf of Governor Martin O'Malley and Lt. Governor Anthony G. Brown, it is my pleasure to announce the approval of \$27,000 in funding for City of Salisbury under the second allocation for FFY 2011 Federal Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) Program.

The ESG is one of several federal funding programs administered by the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) through the Division of Neighborhood Revitalization.

For the second allocation the DHCD received requests for funding from 17 service providers totaling \$374,150. Although we would have liked to fully fund all the requests, the DHCD was able to allocate \$310,911 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to programs providing homelessness prevention and rapid re-housing.

I am pleased to join in this partnership with City of Salisbury in this effort to assist our citizens experiencing difficulty securing housing. A grant agreement will be mailed to your office soon.
