A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDING FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION (GOCCP) UNDER THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING SCHOLARSHIP (LETS) PROGRAM WHICH COVERS THE COST OF SPECIALIZED TRAINING FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention will award grant funds in the amount of \$5,000.00 to the Salisbury Police Department to cover the cost of specialized training for law enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, the Salisbury Police Department has a need for a fully trained K-9 Officer to enhance our response to a variety of street crimes including illegal drug activity, tracking and building searches; and


WHEREAS, this grant will provide funding for one officer to attend a six week "Police K-9 Handler Course" and will cover all expenses including travel, lodging, meals, course fees and training materials; and


WHEREAS, no matching funds are required, no expense will be incurred by the City.
