

RESOLUTION NO. 2212

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES FOR USE OF INMATE WORK CREWS IN CONJUNCTION WITH CITY FORCES

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury desires to enter into an agreement with the Maryland Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services, Poplar Hill Pre-Release Unit to allow the City to use inmate work crews throughout the City on various projects; and


WHEREAS, the terms and conditions of the proposed agreement are set forth in the attached Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), Standard Operating Procedures (SOP), Daily Rate Calculation (DRC); and

WHEREAS, the City has included \$24,000.00 in the fiscal year 2013 budget to reimburse the Maryland Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services for the use of the inmate work crews.




