A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND AGREEING TO THE EXTENSION OF THE ACTING STATUS FOR ACTING CAPTAIN LARRY DODD.

WHEREAS, the City's Employee Handbook provides that employees can only serve in acting status for a term exceeding six months with the advice and consent of the City Council; and


WHEREAS, Larry Dodd has been serving in acting status since May 13, 2012 and will reach the six month anniversary on November 13, 2012; and



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salisbury City Council hereby agrees to extend the acting status of Larry Dodd as Acting Captain for a period not to exceed six (6) months.
