

RESOLUTION NO. 2220

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF A POOL/FLEET VEHICLE AND AN IN-STATION AIR COMPRESSOR FOR THE SALISBURY FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR USE IN ITS EFFORTS TO ENHANCE ITS CAPABILITIES IN PROVIDING THE EFFECTIVE AND EFFICIENT DELIVERY OF FIRE, RESCUE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES TO THE CITY OF SALISBURY AND THE SALISBURY FIRE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the volunteer members of the Salisbury Fire Department constantly seek to enhance the department's capabilities in the effective and efficient delivery of public safety services through their contributions of equipment and apparatus to the City; and

WHEREAS, funds appropriated to the Volunteer Corporations have been expended by the Salisbury Fire Department, Inc. (Fire Station # 16) to purchase one (1) sport utility vehicle valued at \$36,000.00 and one (1) Scott-Hush Series air compressor valued at \$26,056.79, to be donated to the City of Salisbury Fire Department for inclusion in its inventory of emergency vehicles and physical facility assets; and

WHEREAS, the new vehicle will replace a unit that was surplussed in FY09 since it was inoperable and its repair was cost prohibitive; and

WHEREAS, the new compressor increases the Salisbury Fire Department's capabilities to fill self-contained breathing air cylinders for use in firefighting activities; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief and the Mayor have recommended that the City accept the donation of this vehicle and air compressor; and


WHEREAS, the City's gift policy requires that such a gift can only be accepted with the approval of City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the following gifts be accepted and included in the City of Salisbury Fire Department's inventory of emergency vehicles and physical facility assets control inventory:


- (1) 2012 Ford Explorer VIN 1FMHK8D8XCGA80295



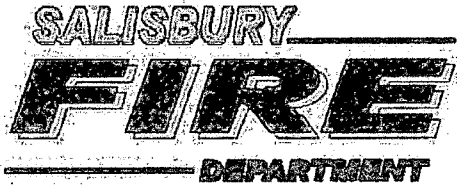

Subject: Gifting from Volunteer Corporations

The members of the Salisbury Fire Department, Inc. (Station 16 Volunteers) corporation have utilized funds appropriated to them to purchase one (1) new vehicle and one (1) new Scott-Hush series air compressor for use in the department's fleet and physical facilities asset control inventory. The projects are described below:

- 2012 Ford Explorer - VIN 1FMHK8D8XCGA80295
- Scott Air Compressor – Hush Series # 6000 Item # AC0503511111

This vehicle replaces a unit (1992 Ford Taurus Wagon) that was surplussed in FY09 that became inoperable and its repair was cost prohibitive. The compressor adds to the fire department's capabilities for replacement of breathing air in all of its firefighting air cylinders. The volunteers wish to gift these assets to the City for inclusion in the Fire Department's fleet vehicle and physical facilities asset inventory. The gifts are valued at \$36,000.00 and \$26,056.79 respectively for a total of \$62,056.79. In compliance with City policy such gifts can only be accepted with the approval of the City Council. Attached you will find a resolution to accept this equipment for consideration by the City Council.
