A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS AWARDED THROUGH THE ORGANIZED CRIME DRUG ENFORCEMENT TASK FORCES (OCDEF) PROGRAM IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE FEDERAL DRUG ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION (DEA) TO PROVIDE FOR OVERTIME REIMBURSEMENT FOR AN OFFICER PARTICIPATING IN INVESTIGATIONS, STRATEGIC INITIATIVES, AND PROSECUTIONS RELATED TO ILLEGAL DRUG VIOLATIONS IN THE CITY OF SALISBURY.

WHEREAS, the OCDEF Program and the DEA have awarded grant funds to the Salisbury Police Department to aid in the investigations, strategic initiatives and prosecutions of illegal drug violations; and


WHEREAS, these funds will provide overtime reimbursement to an officer engaging in additional enforcement activity concerning these violations; and



NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that grant funding from the OCDEF/DEA Program in the amount of \$6,000.00 be accepted and used for overtime reimbursement for an officer assisting in the investigations, strategic initiatives and prosecutions of illegal drug violations in Salisbury, Maryland.
