A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS AWARDED THROUGH THE ORGANIZED CRIME DRUG ENFORCEMENT TASK FORCES (OCDETF) PROGRAM IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE BUREAU OF ALCOHOL, TOBACCO & FIREARMS (ATF) TO PROVIDE FOR OVERTIME REIMBURSEMENT TO OFFICERS PARTICIPATING IN INVESTIGATIONS AND APPROVED STRATEGIC INITIATIVES RELATED TO VIOLATIONS OF THE LAWS RELATING TO ALCOHOL, TOBACCO AND FIREARMS IN THE CITY OF SALISBURY.

WHEREAS, the OCDETF Program and the ATF have awarded grant funds to the Salisbury Police Department to aid in the investigations and strategic initiatives related to alcohol, tobacco and firearms violations; and


WHEREAS, these funds will provide overtime reimbursement to officers engaging in additional enforcement activity concerning these violations; and



NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that grant funding from the OCDETF/ATF Program in the amount of \$17,202.25 be accepted and used for overtime reimbursement for officers assisting in the investigations and approved strategic initiatives related to violations of the ATF laws in Salisbury, Maryland.

THIS RESOLUTION was duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on November 13, 2012, and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.




