A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY ACCEPTING FUNDS IN COOPERATION WITH THE MARYLAND OFFICE OF HIGHWAY SAFETY TO PROVIDE OVERTIME REIMBURSEMENT TO POLICE OFFICERS PARTICIPATING IN A SPECIAL ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM ENTITLED "MOTORCYCLE ENFORCEMENT," TO REDUCE THE OCCURRENCE OF UNSAFE AND UNLAWFUL ACTIONS OF MOTORCYCLE DRIVERS DEMONSTRATING A CONSCIOUS AND WILLFUL DISREGARD OF TRAFFIC SAFETY AS IT PERTAINS TO THE OPERATION OF MOTORCYCLES.

WHEREAS, the Maryland Office of Highway Safety and the Salisbury Police Department will cooperate successfully in serving the people of Salisbury/Wicomico County; and


WHEREAS, this grant funding has been designated for overtime reimbursement hours worked by officers for proactive motorcycle safety enforcement efforts; and

WHEREAS, the use of these overtime funds will allow increased police presence for traffic enforcement during Delmarva Bike Week 2013, which will be held on September 12-15, 2013.




