

RESOLUTION No. 2232

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND TO ACCEPT THE DONATION OF TELEPHONIC AND RADIO RECORDING EQUIPMENT KNOWN AS A "VOICE RECORDER" FROM THE EMERGENCY NUMBER SYSTEMS BOARD (911) WHICH WILL INTERGRATE WITH THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S EXISTING COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT AND ENHANCE EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION WITH POLICE OFFICERS AND THE PUBLIC.

WHEREAS, the State of Maryland Emergency Number Systems Board conducts a review of the Maryland counties 911 Emergency Center every five (5) years to assess equipment upgrade needs; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that the Salisbury Police Department's Voice Recorder is antiquated and nearing the end of the life cycle; and

WHEREAS, a new updated Voice Recorder would integrate with and compliment the current technology now in use in the Police Communication's Center; and


WHEREAS, the Emergency Number Systems Board (911) will purchase and install the new Voice Recorder, resulting in no cost to the City; and


WHEREAS, the City's purchasing policies and procedures will be followed to acquire the new Voice Recorder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND to accept the Telephonic and Radio Recording Equipment (Voice Recorder) valued at \$16,220.40, for use by the Salisbury Police Communications Center to enhance communications with the officers and the public.

THIS RESOLUTION was duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on November 26, 2012, and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.




