**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND AGREEING TO THE
EXTENSION OF THE ACTING STATUS FOR EDWARD JOHNSON, ACTING

WHEREAS, the City's Employee Handbook provides that employees can only serve in acting status for a term exceeding six months with the advice and consent of the City Council; and


WHEREAS, Mr. Edward Johnson has been serving in acting status since June 26, 2012 and will reach the six month anniversary on December 26, 2012; and





I am requesting that the acting status for ACTING UTILITY SECTION CHIEF, Edward Johnson be continued until a permanent UTILITY SECTION CHIEF IS APPOINTED. The City's Employee Handbook requires that the City Council provide advice and consent to allow an employee to serve in an acting capacity for more than six months. Mr. Johnson was named ACTING UTILITY SECTION CHIEF, SEWER DIVISION on June 26, 2012. He will reach his six month anniversary on December 26, 2012.

Mr. Johnson has passed the exam for Superintendent's licensing. The position of UTILITY SECTION CHIEF has been posted and Mr. Johnson has been invited to apply for the position and be interviewed along with other qualified candidates.
