WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury applied for funding on behalf of four providers of services to homeless residents of the City of Salisbury; and


WHEREAS, a grant in the amount of \$61,501.00 was awarded to the City of Salisbury for the following programs;

Samaritan Ministries, Inc.	\$10,938.00





Attached is a Resolution to accept funding from the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for the Emergency Solutions Grant Program. This funding, in the amount of \$61,501.00, will be utilized to provide funding to the following organizations:

Diakonia, Inc.	\$32,813.33
Village of Hope	\$ 9,625.00
Second Chance Help, Inc.	\$ 8,125.00
Samaritan Ministries, Inc.	\$ 10,938.00

The funding will be utilized to assist with the operations costs for the four shelters. Diakonia also serves as the Homeless Prevention Rapid Re-housing vendor for the City of Salisbury. As such their funding includes operational costs and financial assistance for homeless prevention. The City does not have match-funding requirements. This funding level represents a decrease of \$3,375.00 from last year. Please forward the resolution to the City Council for placement on the agenda for February 11, 2013.
