RESOLUTION No. 2261

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND TO ACCEPT FUNDING FOR OVERTIME REIMBURSEMENT FROM THE UNITED STATES MARSHALS SERVICE (USMS) FOR THE SALISBURY POLICE DEPARTMENT'S WARRANT SQUAD INVESTIGATION, ARREST AND PROSECUTION OF PERSONS WHO HAVE ACTIVE STATE AND FEDERAL WARRANTS.

WHEREAS, the Salisbury Police Department's Warrant Squad works in conjunction with the United States Marshals Service to locate wanted subjects in the City of Salisbury and Wicomico County; and


WHEREAS, the United States Marshals Service has funding available for the purpose of reimbursement of overtime salary costs for two Salisbury Police Officers conducting joint law enforcement operations for the investigation and arrest of persons with active warrants; and


WHEREAS, the intent of the joint effort is to investigate and apprehend local, state and federal fugitives primarily wanted for but not limited to: violent crimes against persons, weapons offenses, felony drug offenses and failure to register as a sex offender; thereby improving public safety and reducing violent crime in the City of Salisbury and Wicomico County in support of the Safe Streets mission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that this funding, not to exceed \$26,000.00, be accepted and used for the reimbursement of overtime salary costs related to the investigation, arrest and prosecution of persons wanted on outstanding state and federal warrants.

THIS RESOLUTION was duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on March 11, 2013, and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.


