A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ADOPTING A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN FOR THE FIVE YEAR PERIOD FY 14-18

WHEREAS, it is important for the City to develop a long-range plan showing its capital outlay needs and setting forth a plan for financing those needs; and

WHEREAS, the development of such a plan helps to ensure that the City's long-range capital needs are being addressed in a responsible manner; helps to place those needs in priority order; and helps anticipate the resources that will be available to finance those needs; and

WHEREAS, the City's staff has developed the attached Capital Improvement Plan for the five year period beginning in Fiscal Year 14 and ending in Fiscal Year 18; and


WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the attached Capital Improvement Plan and finds that it reflects the capital needs of the City as can best be reasonably anticipated;




