

RESOLUTION NO. 2282

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY REQUESTING PERMISSION TO ACCEPT, FROM THE U.S. MARSHAL'S SERVICE, TWO NEW VEHICLES CURRENTLY DESCRIBED AS A SILVER 2013 DODGE CARAVAN AND A SILVER 2013 FORD EXPLORER WHICH WILL BE OUTFITTED WITH EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT, ALL AT NO COST TO THE CITY OF SALISBURY AND WILL BE UTILIZED EXCLUSIVELY BY THE OFFICERS ASSIGNED TO THE U.S. MARSHAL'S SERVICE AND THE CAPITOL AREA REGIONAL FUGITIVE TASK FORCE (CARFTF).

WHEREAS, the U.S. Marshal's service has offered to provide the Salisbury Police Department with two new vehicles currently described above, but with the understanding that the make and model may be subject to change before a scheduled delivery date; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Marshal's Service will equip these two new vehicles with the needed emergency equipment, also, at no cost to the City; and

WHEREAS, these vehicles will be utilized exclusively by Salisbury Police Department Officers assigned to the U.S. Marshal's Service and CARFTF; and


WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury would retain ownership of the vehicles and equipment if in the event the SPD Officers are no longer assigned to the U.S. Marshal's Task Force; and


WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury would only be required to title, insure and abide by the vehicle's warranty requirements, pay for fuel and all repairs/maintenance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the Salisbury Police Department be allowed to acquire these two vehicles currently described as a silver 2013 Dodge Grand Caravan SXT and a silver 2013 Ford Explorer both with emergency equipment installed with a total value of approximately \$55,000.00.



SUBJECT: Acquisition of Vehicles

Attached is a Resolution requesting approval for the acquisition of two brand new vehicles from the U.S. Marshal's Service, at no cost to the City. The make and model are subject to change however, as of the date of this correspondence, the vehicles are described as a silver 2013 Dodge Caravan SXT and a silver 2013 Ford Explorer. Also, at no cost to the City, both vehicles will be outfitted, including police radio and all emergency equipment, not to exceed \$5,000.00. Once these vehicles are ordered and arrive, they will be titled directly to the City of Salisbury. The total outfit acquisition is valued at approximately \$55,000.00.

The only stipulation is that these be unmarked vehicles to be utilized by the SPD officers assigned directly to the U.S. Marshal's Service and the Capital Area Regional Fugitive Task Force (CARFTF). However, if there comes a time in which the Salisbury Police could not participate in the (CARFTF), for any reason, the vehicles would remain the property of the City and could be utilized in whatever capacity deemed appropriate.

The cost to the City of Salisbury would include, titling, registering, insuring, general maintenance and fuel. The City would also benefit from the full warranty on both vehicles, which would cover any repairs during that period.
