A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ACCEPTING A DONATION OF USED BRICKS FROM THE OWNER OF LIFETIME MASONRY WHICH WILL BE USED TO INSTALL A BRICK MEMORY AREA TO HONOR DECEASED, RETIRED AND CURRENT POLICE OFFICERS AT THE BACK ENTRANCE OF POLICE HEADQUARTERS AND WILL BE A TRIBUTE TO THEIR SERVICE TO THIS CITY.

WHEREAS, the intent of the Salisbury Police Department is to honor many of the deceased, retired and current employees by installing a brick paver memory area; and

WHEREAS, many retired and current employees have purchased bricks which have been engraved with their names, rank, and dates of employment to be placed in this area; and





THIS RESOLUTION was duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on June 10, 2013, and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.


