


BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Salisbury, Maryland that the following individual is appointed to the Historic District Commission for the term ending as indicated:

The above resolution was introduced, read and passed at the regular meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on the 11 day of August 2014.




Re: Salisbury Historic District Commission
