A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ACCEPTING OVERTIME REIMBURSEMENT FUNDING FROM THE UNITED STATES MARSHALS SERVICE (USMS) FOR THE SALISBURY POLICE DEPARTMENT'S OFFICERS ASSIGNED TO THE CAPITAL AREA REGIONAL FUGITIVE TASK FORCE.

WHEREAS, the United States Marshals Service has funding available for the purpose of reimbursement of overtime salary costs for two Salisbury Police Officers conducting joint law enforcement operations for the investigation and arrest of persons with active warrants: and

WHEREAS, the intent of the joint effort is to investigate and apprehend local, state and federal fugitives primarily wanted for but not limited to: violent crimes against persons, weapons offenses, felony drug offenses and failure to register as a sex offender. The participate in the effort improves public safety and reduces violent crime in the City of Salisbury and Wicomico County in support of the Safe Streets mission; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police is authorized to sign an MOU and enter into a cooperative effort between the United States Marshals Service and the Salisbury Police Department that will provide a safer environment and improve the quality of life for the citizens of the City of Salisbury and Wicomico County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that this funding, not to exceed \$30,000.00 (thirty thousand dollars), be accepted and used for the reimbursement of overtime salary costs related to the investigation, arrest and prosecution of persons who are wanted on outstanding warrants.

THIS RESOLUTION was duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on March 9, 2015, and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.
