A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, TO AMEND THE MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS OF THE BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury established a Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee with Resolution 2401 approved on May 27, 2014; and

**WHEREAS,** the City would like to extend and stagger the membership terms for the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee members.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** be it resolved by the City of Salisbury, Maryland, that the membership requirements for the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee are hereby amended as follows:

Membership. The members of the Committee shall be no fewer than five (5) and no more than seven (7) persons, the majority of whom shall be city residents at the time of their appointment. Members shall serve staggered terms of four (4) years; three (3) members will serve four (4) year terms beginning and ending in odd years, and two (2) to four (4) members will serve four (4) year terms beginning and ending in even years. To accomplish this, two (2) of the current members will have their current term extended one (1) year to end in an even year. If a member resigns from the committee in the middle of a term their replacement will serve the remaining length of the resigning member's term. There will be one (1), non-voting, ex-officio member from the Salisbury-Wicomico Metropolitan Planning Organization. All members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council to serve terms of three (3) years. Members shall be subject to removal by the Mayor and Council.

THE ABOVE RESOLUTION was introduced and duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on the day of June, 2015, and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.
