A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A PROJECT TO CONSTRUCT OR REHABILITATE A MINIMUM OF FOUR HOMES IN THE GREATER CHURCH STREET NEIGHBORHOOD TO BE SOLD TO LOW OR VERY LOW INCOME FAMILIES OVER THE NEXT TWO YEARS

WHEREAS, Habitat for Humanity of Wicomico County, Inc., a nonprofit organization, proposes to undertake the project described above (the "Project"); and




