

RESOLUTION NO. 2531

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY ACCEPTING FUNDS AWARDED THROUGH THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, WATERWAY IMPROVEMENT FUND GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,000 FOR UTILITY PEDESTALS AT THE PORT OF SALISBURY MARINA.

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Natural Resources has the Waterway Improvement Fund program which supports the development, use, and enjoyment of all waters of the State of Maryland for the benefit of the general boating public; and

WHEREAS, the Waterway Improvement Fund provides financial support to local governments for capital projects and services for the boating public; and

WHEREAS, the Port of Salisbury Marina has electric pedestals at the boat slips; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury desires to replace and upgrade the pedestals to provide electric, lighting, water, phone and cable capabilities in the Salisbury Marina; and


WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury will coordinate the design, procurement and installation of the pedestals; and

WHEREAS, the project will provide improvements to benefit the general boating public along the Wicomico River.



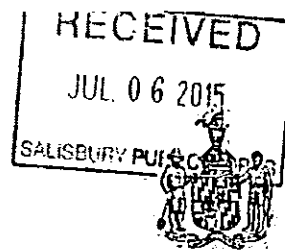

Re: Waterway Improvement Fund Grant – Salisbury Marina Pedestal replacement project

The City of Salisbury has been awarded a Waterway Improvement Fund grant in the amount of \$25,000 from the Maryland Department of Natural Resources. The grant will fund the upgrade and replacement of pedestals at the Port of Salisbury Marina. The project was identified in the City's FY16 Capital Improvements Plan (Project #M0002). The existing pedestals only have electrical service. The grant will be used to install new pedestals which will have electric, lighting, water, phone and cable capabilities. The total project cost was estimated to be \$50,000. The first sections to be replaced will include annual renters.

Attached is a Resolution for consideration to accept the Waterway Improvement Fund grant in the amount of \$25,000.
