**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND TO COMBINE THE RECYCLING ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND THE SUSTAINABILITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE (GREEN TEAM) INTO ONE ADVISORY COMMITTEE THAT RETAINS THE TITLE OF THE SUSTAINABILITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the Recycling Advisory Committee was formed in 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Recycling Advisory Committee has no appointed members at the present time; and

WHEREAS, the Sustainability Advisory Committee (Green Team) is a newly formed committee; and

WHEREAS, the goals of the Recycling Advisory Committee align with the stated goals of the Sustainability Advisory Committee (Green Team); and


WHEREAS, the Sustainability Advisory Committee (Green Team) will lead the charge to help the City of Salisbury achieve and maintain Sustainable Maryland Certification, as well as, help develop policies, assist with identifying grant opportunities, implement programs, and assist with educational opportunities for staff and community leaders; and


WHEREAS, the total membership of the Sustainability Advisory Committee (Green Team) shall remain the same, and consist of five (5) residents of the City of Salisbury, who shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council to serve staggered terms of three (3) years.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Salisbury City Council that the Recycling Advisory Committee is hereby dissolved, and its missions folded into those of the Sustainability Advisory Committee (Green Team).


THIS RESOLUTION was duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on May 23, 2016, and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.
