

AS AMENDED ON MARCH 12, 2012
ORDINANCE NO. 2195

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING A BUDGET AMENDMENT OF THE FY12 GENERAL FUND TO APPROPRIATE THE FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT INSURANCE TRUST (LGIT) FOR DAMAGE INCURRED BY A LIGHTNING STRIKE TO THE SALISBURY ZOO'S TELEPHONE AND INTERNET SYSTEMS.

WHEREAS, the Salisbury Zoo's telephone and Internet systems were seriously damaged by a lightning strike that occurred during the evening of August 12, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the insurance claim paid by the Local Government Insurance Trust amounted to \$3,640.90, which was deposited into the City of Salisbury's General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Salisbury Zoo already repaired the damaged buildings, and now has insufficient funds in the Building Maintenance Account, 40000-534301 to cover other necessary building repairs.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, that the City's Fiscal Year 2012 General Fund Budget be amended as follows:


- 1) Increase Insurance Proceeds (01000-456935) by \$3,640.90
- 2) Increase the Salisbury Zoo's budget (40000-534301) \$3640.90

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on this 12th day of March, 2012, and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, was finally passed by the Council on the 26th day of March, 2012.


